
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## PREFACE

The present volume contains the proceedings of an International Symposium on Interval Mathematics held in Freiburg i.Br./Germany from September 23 to 26, 1985.

The last two such international symposia took place in Karlsruhe/ Germany in 1975 and also in Freiburg i.Br./Germany in 1980.
